Have you been Baptised? Have you been Confirmed?



What is Baptism?

Whenever it happens, whether as a baby, child or adult, baptism is at the heart of an amazing journey of faith. You are never too old to take this step, and being baptized as an adult or child is a wonderful experience.

It declares you a follower of Jesus Christ and a part of this wonderful family of God.

If you have not been baptised... would you like to find out more?

What is Confirmation?

Confirmation is a special service in which a person confirms the promises that were made when they were baptised. If you were baptised when you were a child, your parents and godparents made these promises on your behalf.

As a young person or adult, you may be ready to affirm these promises for yourself and commit your life to following Jesus Christ. It would be at this point that you would receive Holy Communion.

In the service the Bishop will lay their hands on your head and ask God's Holy Spirit to give you the strength and commitment to live God's way for the rest of your life.
