Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> February

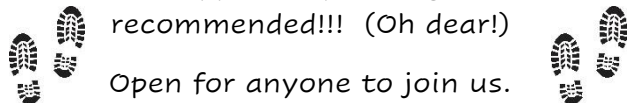
Within the Church of England, we would like to encourage our young people to step into areas of leadership... and to offer opportunities to explore their faith and spirituality.
