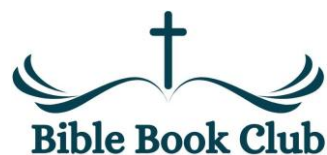

FUNDRAISING PROJECT AND GRANT

It has been over 25 years since our church was last decorated and with our wall drying out in the north aisle, we thought this would be a wonderful opportunity to begin to raise the money to redecorate our church

With a cost just under £30,000 to redecorate, as churches of our age need specialist paints and care when work is carried out., Friends of Flitwick Church are supporting this project and wonderfully they were awarded a grant of £10,000 towards the costs, which takes us a third of the way there already.
