As an initial response we have made a few adjustments and more will follow:

- ❖ For those who would like to read our service books from a device to enlarge the print, we will be making our service books available on our website for you to download by Friday 17th July. (Over the course of time, we plan to print a few large-print service books)
- ❖ For Wednesday mid-week communion, the minister will wear a microphone to help with clarity and volume
- ❖ Fidget toys and ear defenders are available in the children's corner - any and all are welcome to use these.
- ❖ For those who highlighted how uncomfortable they find the seating, the faculty for the chairs is now sitting with the Diocese, who are keen to help us make this happen. We are awaiting some responses from external organisations. Bear with us... its 'work in progress'... we hope not to long now.
