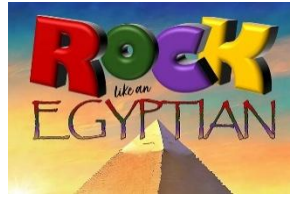
All are welcome to join at 7.30pm for choral led Communion service with footwashing (optional) and vigil until midnight (also optional!!)
