Church Building News

Exciting News!

We're delighted to share some fantastic news. Over the last month, Friends of Flitwick Church has secured a grant of **£10,000**. Combined with a very generous donation of **£9,000**, and along with funds raised through recent events such as the Cream Tea and Quiz Night, we now have enough funding to redecorate our church. Our church has not been redecorated for over 20 years and is beginning to look rather tired, so this work will make a tremendous difference to the building and everyone who uses it. A faculty application has now been submitted to the Diocese, and we hope the work can be carried out before Christmas or, if necessary, at the beginning of 2027.

Chairs Update

The faculty application to replace the pews with chairs—which will improve accessibility, comfort and flexibility—has involved a number of discussions with the Diocese. Following a recent meeting, a revised proposal has been submitted. This plan retains four of the shorter pews, complete with their kneeling boards, at the back of the North Aisle, where the Children's corner is currently located. This is the proposal we will now be taking forward. We are hopeful that the chair project will progress alongside the redecoration work, enabling us to create a brighter, cleaner and more accessible church for everyone. We look forward to sharing further updates as the project moves ahead.

Service Change

9am Said Service - First Sunday Of the month

Around a year ago, after listening to the needs of our congregation, we introduced a quieter Said Holy Communion service at 9.00am on the first Sunday of each month.

While this service has been appreciated by those who attended, numbers have gradually declined. After careful consideration, we have decided to **discontinue the 9.00am on the first Sunday of the Month service.**

Going forward, on the first Sunday of each month we will come together as one church family at our All Together Service at 10.30am. We look forward to worshipping together as a whole church community and continuing to grow in faith and fellowship. Thank you to everyone who has supported the 9.00am service over the past year.
